This one-day symposium is designed to draw together the many disciplines participating in energy related research in the University.

The event is outcome-focused with an emphasis on practical solutions to sustainable energy challenges. It is centered upon younger academics; the students, post-graduates, and un-established post-doctoral researchers who will be the leaders of tomorrow.

This inaugural Annual Energy Symposium is built around an emerging area of research interest which is inclusive of most of the University's energy research community: 'The UK Energy Portfolio - the role of Decentralised Energy'.

This day-long event will be free.

This symposium is for academics and researchers from science, technology, social-science and policy backgrounds and aims to reflect the broad expertise within the energy research ecosystem at Cambridge.

We invite post-graduate students looking to find direction for their future research and careers, post-doctoral academics who wish to establish their own research in the topic of sustainable energy, established academics looking for ideas or to recruit students in this field, and industrial or commercial entities looking for collaborative research-focused opportunities.

Undergraduates seeking opportunities for further studies in a socially relevant area of research will also find this event useful.

One of the aims of the symposium is to give all delegates the opportunity to explore how their interests can mesh within the broader theme of sustainable energy and therefore we encourage participation at all levels of interest and expertise.

The Cambridge Energy Forum is increasing communication between the technologies, economic analysts, researchers and businesses in the Greater Cambridge area.
